Your child will need to wear their school t-shirt and jumper, a waterproof coat, and wellies (if their wellies are already at school, we will take these). They will need some trainers to change into, and a water bottle. Please apply suncream to your child on the morning of the visit. Please do not send suncream into school. They will need to wear long jogging trousers or leggings as we will be walking through long grass. **No shorts please.**
