Guidance for completing the art work:

- Pastels (*chalk or oil*)
- Paints (*all techniques and media*)
- Collage (*including paper and fabric - ensure these are stuck well*)
- Felt Tips
- Line drawings in ink
- Inks
- Printing
- Charcoal
- Glitter



DO NOT USE

- Coloured pencils or pencil drawings
- Same coloured media or material on the same coloured background
- Pencils or coloured pencils onto coloured paper
- Metallic pens & paint
- Photos printed on glossy paper
- Reflective/shiny papers or materials
- Sellotape or transparent film
