Dear Parents and Carers,

Community Learning Art Day – Wednesday 22nd May 2024

We are writing to let you know about our plans for our Community Learning Art Day.

This will be taking place on Wednesday 22nd May 2024. It will be a community learning day **with pupils from the Infants and Juniors learning together at the Dunbury Juniors site, Winterborne Whitechurch.**



The focus of the day will be to create two pieces of artwork inspired by the work of Mr Finch.

This ties in with our Learning Larks and our biblical underpinning.

We have already made arrangements for all children who travel by bus to be dropped off and collected from Dunbury Juniors. The buses ML005, ML006, ML007 and ML14 have been asked to collect the children as usual in the mornings and bring them to the Junior site instead of the Infant site and then collect from there in the afternoon. The children who catch the bus from Winterborne Whitechurch can come straight to the Junior site that day and be collected from there as they did for Faith Day.

We would be grateful if the parents of the children who do not use buses to get to school at the Infant site could contact the school office to let us know whether you are able to make arrangements to drop off and collect your child from the Junior site on Wednesday 22nd May, or whether you require support with this.

The gates will be open for children to arrive between 8:30 and 8:45 and will be open again at 3:15 for collecting children. All pupils who are being collected from the Junior site will be waiting on the playground with a member of staff.

The office has created an event on the Local Food Links site so that all pupils can order a packed lunch for that day if they wish to.

We are looking forward to a great day of learning and creativity all together. At the end of the day, the children's artwork will be set up in the school hall. Parents will have the opportunity to look around. We will also be creating a virtual tour for any parents who are unable to visit in person.
