Beech class trip to Launceston Farm, Blandford - Tuesday 4th June 2024

I am delighted to confirm that as part of our topic 'Amazing Animals', which will start on our return to school after half term, we are planning a trip to Launceston Farm. The date of our visit is **Tuesday 4th June**. We will be taking part in bug sweeping/identifying, and baking activities as well as looking at how animals on the farm are reared. The trip is free of charge due to funding and grants from the Education Fund which have been awarded to support the educational experience.

<u>Lunches</u> -The trip will happen during the morning, and we will return after lunch. An 'Event' has been created on Local Food Links online system. The hot school meal option for this day has been replaced with a packed lunch option. If you require a packed lunch for your child on this day, please log in to the online ordering system and select your child's choice of sandwich filling. If you do not require a packed lunch to be provided by Local Food Links, please ensure your child brings their own packed lunch.

<u>Arbor Consent -</u> Please **consent in Arbor** for your child to attend this trip and through doing so, consent to your child, in the event of an accident or emergency, receiving first aid treatment and or pain relief from a doctor or paramedic. If you are unable to do this through Arbor, please complete and return the slip below by **Tuesday 14**th **May.**

Your child will need to wear their school uniform t-shirt and jumper, a waterproof coat, and wellies. They will need to wear long jogging trousers or leggings. No shorts please.

Please contact the base staff through the class email (<u>beech@dunbury.dsat.org.uk</u>) if you are able to volunteer and join us on the trip to help supervise the children. We would really appreciate a parent to accompany us if possible.

We look forward to an exciting adventure to the farm. I will ensure that we share photos in our next newsletter to support conversations with your child.
