Dear Parents,

Leeson House Year 4 Residential Visit
Wednesday 13th - Friday 15th March 2024

We are very pleased to be able to once again offer a residential trip for Year 4. We will be taking them to Leeson House. It is located near Langton Matravers and is situated in its own grounds, with excellent facilities and exciting, adventurous activities. The accommodation is of a very high standard and the centre specialises in providing healthy, child friendly meals.

The children will depart on the morning of Wednesday 13th March and will return on Friday 15th March. They will come to school as normal (although not in school uniform) on the Wednesday morning and will be arriving back before the end of the school day on Friday. Two members of staff will accompany the children.

Booking and Deposit

We are asking for a contribution towards the trip from parents of approximately £165 per child. The cost includes coach travel to and from the venue, all meals (except lunch on the first day) and three days' worth of activities with Leeson's qualified instructors. A deposit of £40 and returned permission slip is needed to secure a place on the trip, which is due by **Monday 2nd October 2023**. Once all deposits have been received, we will confirm numbers with the provider and secure transport and therefore be in a position to confirm final costs. After this date, we will be unable to book a place for your child.

Payment Schedule

To support paying the balance of this trip, we have set up payments in Arbor that allow you to contribute towards the cost of the trip throughout the year. Any amount can be paid at any time from £1.00 through to the full total cost of the trip. To ensure that the full costs of this trip are met, we require the following payment due dates to be met.
