Dear Parents and Carers,

Sports Community Learning Day, Leaver's Service and Summer Fair - Wednesday 19th July 2023

We are really looking forward to welcoming you to a day of celebration at Dunbury Academy. On **Wednesday 19th July**, we will be holding our last community learning day of the term. All children will attend school at the Junior site so that as a whole school community, we can enjoy a morning of sport, bid farewell to our leavers in the afternoon and then have fun together at the Summer Fair.

Transport to Dunbury Juniors

The buses ML005, ML006 and ML007 have been asked to collect the children as usual in the mornings and bring them to the Junior site instead of the Infant site and then collect from there in the afternoon. The children who catch the bus from Winterborne Whitechurch can come straight to the Junior site that day and be collected from there.

We would be grateful if the parents of the children who do not use buses to get to school at the Infant site, could contact the school office to let us know whether you are able to make arrangements to drop off and collect your child from the Junior site on Wednesday 19th July or whether you require support with this.

The gates will be open for children to arrive between 8:30 and 8:45 and will be open again at 3:15 for collecting children.

If you wish to collect your child from school to attend the Summer Fair, please ensure that you have informed the office before 14:30.

Lunches

There will be no hot school meals on this day. An 'Event' has been created on Local Food Links online system. The hot school meal option for this day has been replaced with a packed lunch option. If you require a packed lunch for your child on this day, please log in to the online ordering system and select your child's choice of sandwich filling. If you do not require a packed lunch to be provided by Local Food Links, please ensure your child brings their own packed lunch.

Sports Teams

The children will be competing in events that they have been practising in their PE sessions throughout the year. The children have been allocated a team colour for the day and we will let you know this colour soon. Please can children come to school in their PE kit and coloured shirt, which they can wear throughout the day. We know that not all children will have the right colour. If this is a struggle, please ask your child to wear their normal PE kit and we will supply a coloured band to wear.

Come and Join us

We would like to invite parents to join us for our sports morning. We are hoping to start the morning events at around 9:30. We anticipate that the sporting events will be completed by mid to late morning. FODA are planning to sell refreshments before Sports Day starts and throughout the morning. Where possible, we will set up the events to take place within the painted track on the field and ask parents to stay on the outside of the track, to allow the children space to compete.

Year 6 Leaver's Service

We will be attending a service at St Mary's Church at 2:00pm to say goodbye to our Year 6 leavers. Parents of Year 6 are welcome to join us for this event. Please can we ask parents joining us to use the seating at the back of the church to allow us to seat the school children on our arrival.

Summer Fair

Following our community learning day together at the Junior site, FODA will be running their Summer Fair from 3:30 to 5:00. Please come and join in supporting us in this exciting event. Look out for more details coming soon.
